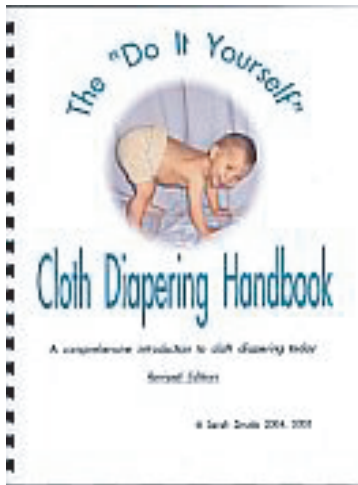


Should I Cloth Diaper my Baby?
